
Flexible Response

- Flexible Response instead of Massive Retaliation
- Mutual Deterrence
- * Aggression short of Nukes!!



Camelot

- The best and the brightest
- young, smart, top in their field
- advisors took a very active role in the decisions of the JFK administration



Stimulating the Economy

- Deficit Spending to spur economic growth (like FDR's New Deal)
- Increase Gov't Spending:
- more public spending = more \$ in the economy
- Lower Taxes:
 - = more \$ to invest& spend

- defense
- up minimum wage
- unemployment insurance extended
- assist cities with high unemployment

Tackling Poverty

Peace Corps:

- volunteer assistance to developing nations (Asia & Latin America)
- by 1968 more than 35,000 volunteers in 60 nations worldwide



Tackling Poverty

- * Alliance for Progress:
 - foreign aid program
 - economic & technological assistance in Latin America
 - improved standard of living (schools, housing, sanitation)

Race to the Moon

- April, 1961 the Soviets launched a manned ship into orbit around the world
- JFK to Congress:
- * the United States "should commit itself to achieving the goal, before the decade is out, of landing a man on the moon and returning him to earth"

Man on the Moon

- National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA)
- July 20, 1969 US Astronaut Neil Armstrong became the first man to set foot on the moon
- Increase in science education in schools



New Domestic Agenda

- In the South the cry, "Freedom Now!" was being heard loud & clear
- JFK = some of the most controversial civil rights battles to date
- Presented Congress with a comprehensive & revolutionary Civil Rights Bill... "Kennedy Mystique"

Cuban Missile Crisis

- Bay of Pigs (1961)
- Eisenhower begins plans for CIA backed overthrow of Cuba (Fidel Castro = pro-Communism)
- Cuban exiles trained for an invasion
- JFK pulls air support fearing Soviet response
- Invasion is a failure and an international embarrassment
- Castro forced to seek aid from USSR

Cuban Missile Crisis

- USSR establishes missile bases in Cuba
- Khrushchev lies about missiles
- JFK blockades Cuba to prevent more missiles
- US troops prepare for an invasion
- Both sides come to brink of nuclear war before cutting a deal



 Sent "advisors" to Vietnam to stop Communism




Assassination of JFK
